JONES & WAGENER BURSARY SCHEME 2011

Jones & Wagener is pleased to offer a limited number of bursaries for Civil Engineering students studying at South African Universities. The bursaries will cover university tuition fees, accommodation and a limited living allowance. The combined value of the bursaries will be limited to approximately R65000 per year for the 2012 academic year but may vary depending on the actual university tuition and accommodation fees.

South African students and Grade 12 scholars are invited to submit applications. Students busy with or interested in post-graduate studies in geotechnical, environmental or structural engineering are also welcome to apply.

The award of bursaries will be carried out based on academic merit and financial need. Jones & Wagener is required to implement Black Economic Empowerment and therefore bursaries will be awarded to reflect the population composition of South Africa.

Students studying with Jones & Wagener bursaries will be required to do six weeks paid vacation work at our offices in Rivonia during the July and/or December recess. After completion of his/her studies bursary students will be required to work for Jones & Wagener for a period equal to the period for which the bursary was held.

The closing date for applications is 31 July 2011.
